Reverting to my Classing Letters of the 10th May and 17th June last, in view of the fact that the required capacity tests have been carried out on the safety valves fitted to the boilers of this ship, the Committee, at their meeting today, have assigned a class #100 AL "Carrying Petroleum in Bulk" together with the appropriate notations recommended in your first entry Report No. 480.

The class has been made subject to permanent repairs being carried out to indented side shell plating, etc. in way of cargo hold, starboard side, by the next drydocking.
