Dear Sir,

With regard to your letter dated 27th November in connection with the steamer "LIMA", I beg to state that this vessel arrived here on the 20th instant from Brazil with some cargo and passengers for Lisbon, but is continuing her voyage to Hamburg with cargo in all holds except No. 2 and also passengers, via Leixoes, Havre and Antwerp and under the circumstances I was not able to carry out the full general examination of the hull. Machinery and boilers have been examined with the exception of the port main boiler. Vessel was booked for sailing today but is doing so tomorrow or Wednesday the 29th instant. I have not been able to ascertain what vessel is doing after discharging at Hamburg but so far as I can gather she will be further loading cargo there also passengers for Brazil, via Lisbon again, returning to the latter port in about 4 weeks.
