With respect to the Case of the Steamers
"Olivine" & "Tourmaline" and the London
Letter of the 21st inst. they to enclose for
the Committee's further information a
letter from the Engine Builder Mr.
W. & E. Lidgerwood, from which it will
be observed that as compensation for the
one feed & one bilge pump on the main
Engines an additional feeding Donkey
Pump is actually ^{fitted} in those vessels and
the bilge pumps can if required be used
for feed. There is also the 3" Ejector for
the bilges. Mr. Lidgerwood has written
to the Owners asking them to supply him
with a letter for the Committee confirming
their Specification & wishes as to their pumping
arrangements. It is to be regretted that those
omissions as above were not observed on the

Reports before placing them before the
Committee. The builder will also in future
Cases, see that the details^{all} are entered on
the Reports before attributing his Signature
to same.
