Dear Sir,

I would refer to recent correspondence (Ship) which has taken place between London and Glasgow regarding the conversion of the motorship "GENEVE" ex "CALIFORNIA STANDARD" from an Oil Carrier to an Ore Carrier.

The conversion plans have been approved in this Office and the ship has been under survey at Greenock since the 20th August last.

I now enclose a copy of a letter dated the 9th instant which has been received from the Greenock Surveyors, together with a copy of a communication addressed to them by Caldwell Brothers (Marine) Ltd., Greenock, from which you will note that the Owners' Representatives have now decided to have the vessel classed with the American Bureau of Shipping.

When the report on the survey work completed to date has been received from the Surveyors at Greenock, it will be submitted to the Sub-Committee of Classification for their consideration.
