Two sets of single reduction geared auxiliary steam turbine machinery each designed for an output of 550 KW at 1200 revs/min of alternator, turbine numbers 2.355/6.

The above machinery has been constructed under Special Survey in accordance with the approved plans, the Secretary's letters and the Society's Rules. The workmanship is good. The machinery has been dispatched to St-Nazaire for installation in the above ship.
