"WEATHERTIGHT SIDE SCUTTLES HAVING DEADLIGHTS LIFELINES
"PROVIDED AND RECLASSIFICATION SURVEY COMPLETED STOP ANY
"FOREAND AFTERS REQUIRING RENTWAL TO BE CONVENTION SCANT-
"LINGS - LLOYDS REGISTER".

The conditions stipulated are being carried out and it is expected to complete the reclassification survey at an early date.

It will be noted that instead of fitting the girders under the upper deck in lieu of sheathing, the sheathing of wood as originally fitted was renewed.

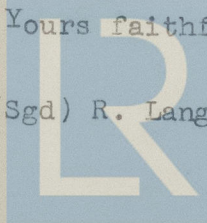
