

T.S.S. "MANUEL CALVO"

Registered Dimensions:- 421' x 48' x 29.2'

This vessel, which is of the three deck type, with poop, bridge and forecastle, was built in 1892 to class with this Society.

The classification subsequently lapsed, and a telephone message has now been received from Mr. Bryden stating that the vessel is to be reclassified 100A1, and that the Owners desire a new freeboard to be assigned.

The freeboard certificate issued in 1906 gave no reduction in freeboard from that originally assigned, but under the present regulations a reduction of 5" could be permitted, and Mr. Bryden desires to know if it will be in order to do this.

It is submitted Mr. Bryden be informed, by wire as requested, that as the vessel holds the Society's highest class the minimum freeboard under the present regulations can be assigned.
