**CONFIRMATION OF LETTER.**

**Lloyd's Register of Shipping,**

17th August, 1918.

Dear Sirs

I have to acquaint you that the wood schooner "MARIE JEANNE" No. 211 in the Register Book has recently been surveyed by the Society's Surveyor at St. Malo for Classification with this Society, and the Committee have assigned to her the record A (in red) with record of Survey 7.18, and notation S.S. St. M. 18 - 5 years. To complete the equipment and render the Vessel eligible to be recommended for the figure "1", the 3 bower anchors which have been placed on board will require to be tested. It is understood that this will be done on the Vessel's arrival in the Bristol Channel when a stream and kedge anchor will be supplied, and I have to inform you that in addition to the anchors 45 fathoms of 9/16" stream chain or a 2" steel wire will require to be placed on board.

I shall therefore be glad if you will give this matter attention should the Vessel arrive in your district.
