Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "COMMANDANT GAMAS", I beg to inform you that I am in receipt of a communication from the Society's Surveyors at Bordeaux, from which it appears that it is not your intention to continue the classification of this vessel with this Society, and having submitted the case for the consideration of the Committee at their meeting to-day, I am directed to inform you that in view of your intimation instructions have been given for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this office.
