Sir,

D. I am directed to acquaint you for the information of the Glasgow Committee that the classings of the ships named in the Glasgow and Greenock Reports of Survey (Gls. Nos. 23,334-23,350 & 23,352 and Greenock Nos. 14,502, 8 & 9) were confirmed by the General Committee at their Special Meeting this day.

With reference to Greenock First Entry Report No. 14,500 on the steamer "BESSIE DOLLAR", the Committee determined in view of their recent decision as set forth in Circular No.1082 as to the notations to be made in the Register Book in cases in which intermediate bulkheads are omitted, to class this vessel ~~1100A1~~ (Spar Deck) Steel with a notation of "Intermediate bulkhead in after hold dispensed with. 5BH only," instead of the notation originally intended, viz:- "For the Timber trade. 5BH only."

I have at the same time to say that the recommendations contained in the Report, dated 23rd November, of the Technical Committee, a copy of which is enclosed, were approved and adopted by the General Committee.
