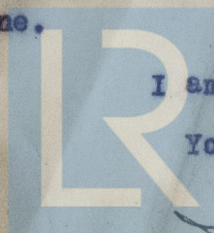
The vessel is now in this district and is, I understand, being classed by the local Society, and the Owners have now stated that they do not wish to continue our classification.
