With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your Steamer "KINRYO MARU", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have to-day had before them a cablegram received from the Society's Surveyors at Kobe, from which it appears that it is not your intention to maintain the classification of this vessel in the Society's Register Book.

As you are aware, the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules for the completion of the Second Special Survey No. 2 expired in June last, and in these circumstances the Committee regret they have no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Society's Register Book with a red line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.
