m.s. "NUCULANA" (now named "AVE" +
No. 73435 in R.B.)

It is understood this vessel is now the property of North Bulk Carriers Ltd., of Santander, and that she has been lying at Ferrol since the 14th June last. Previously she had been laid up in the London area.

The survey position is as follows:- she became due for Special Survey at the end of February, 1958, and I enclose a copy of Newcastle report No. 114146 (Rpt. 8) dated January/February, 1957 which relates to this inspection so far as the hull is concerned. A copy of a memorandum dealing with the machinery Continuous Survey is also enclosed. The Donkey Boiler Survey became due at the end of February, 1958 and the Screwshaft Survey will become due at the end of December, 1958.

The vessel's class has been maintained subject to indented side shellplating etc. (port and starboard) being dealt with by completion of the Special Survey and to the propeller being specially examined at the next drydocking, also to Metalock repair to the main engine A.frame in way of No. 6 journal being examined by February, 1958.

I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the new Owners at Santander and let me know their intentions for dealing with the outstanding matters of survey for maintenance of class in the Society's Register Book.

Copies of this letter and of the enclosure are being forwarded to the Society's Surveyors at Madrid and Vigo.
