Dear Sirs,

s.s. "CHUY" and "NAVEM MONICA"

The cases of these two ships have today been reviewed by the Committee in the light of your letter of the 13th instant.

So far as the "CHUY" is concerned, the Committee have decided not to implement their previous decision to suspend class, and have agreed to the overdue Special Survey being deferred until the vessel is drydocked at your port early next month. They desire you, however, to impress upon the Owners that the survey must be held without fail as now stated early in November otherwise further continuance of class will not be approved.

In the case of the "NAVEM MONICA", the fact that class has been suspended will appear in the November Supplement to be issued in a few days' time, and the Committee consider it would convey a false impression if they were to lift that suspension without their requirements receiving due compliance.

This vessel must therefore remain out of class for the time being, but it will be quite in order to inform the Owners that class will be reinstated on satisfactory completion of the outstanding surveys.

I shall be obliged if you will kindly keep me advised as to any developments in these cases.
