s.s. "NAVEM MONICA" & "CHUY"

I have to acquaint you that these cases have been considered by the Committee today in conjunction with your letter of the 11th September, and they desire me to point out that they cannot agree to these ships remaining in class if the Special Surveys are not to be held until early next year.

They have therefore decided to accept the Owners' suggestion, and have given instructions for the notation of "Class Suspended - Surveys overdue 9,59." to be posted in each case, but this posting will not take place in the "NAVEM MONICA" until 1st October, whilst in the case of the "CHUY" posting will take place on the 1st November, i.e. on the expiration of the year of grace.

You will appreciate that if the carrying out of the overdue Special Surveys for reinstatement of full class is unduly delayed, the Committee may desire to reconsider this decision with a view to the amendment of the notations to "Class Expunged - Non-compliance with the Regulations".
