agreed The class of this ship was expunged for non-compliance with the Regulations on the 8th July, 1958, and reinstated on the 8th September, 1958, when postponement of the Special Survey until September, 1959, was approved. On 11th September a proposal to deal with all repairs by about the middle of November, 1959, was placed before the Committee, who required a definite reason why the Owners wished to postpone the Special Survey for 2 months beyond the expiration of the year of grace.

proposal:- The Rio de Janeiro Surveyors now write that the Owners state that they are unable to carry out the Special Survey on this ship and the "CHUY" until 1960, due to their already congested programme of repairs and oil fuel conversions. The Owners feel unable to make any promises at this stage which, in the existing circumstances, would be an endorsement and conditions in Brazil, they will be unable to keep; and they estimate that should the Committee find it essential to deal with the condition of this ship and that of the "CHUY" a notation of "Class Suspended - repairs overdue" might be assigned.
