Dear Sir,

We beg leave to revert to previous correspondence concerning these two cases, and have now to report that the Owners state that they are unable to carryout the Special Surveys on these two ships until early 1960, due to their already congested programme for repairs and Oil Fuel Conversions.

They also realise that the 12 months' period, which the Committee allow for the holding and completion of Special Surveys, will very shortly expire, and the Owners request that, should the Committee find it essential to deal with the Class, of their two ships, that they may be favourably considered for the Notation of "Class Suspended-Surveys Overdue".

We would add that this Company has assured your Surveyors at this port, that they will present these ships for Survey, as soon as possible, but they frankly see but little reason for making promises, at this stage, which they know all too well that they cannot carryout in the existing circumstances and conditions in this country.
