Motorships "JULIAN" and "TITANIAN"

I acknowledge receipt of your letter of the 16th instant, the contents of which have been noted.

So far as the "JULIAN" is concerned, a letter dated the 14th instant was received from the Owners last week to the effect that the class of the ship was being transferred to the Norske Veritas. The case has received the consideration of the Committee on Friday when instructions were given for a notation to be recorded in the Register Book against the ship's name indicating that the class has been withdrawn at the Owners' request. The letter of the 13th instant need not, in the circumstances, be sent to the Owners.

In the case of the "TITANIAN", if it is the Owners' intention to relinquish the Society's class, I shall be glad if you will make arrangements for this office to be informed officially by the Owners.
