We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your classing letter of the 5th instant respecting the above vessel, and have carefully noted the contents.

In reply to your enquiries we have to inform you as follows:-

1. Seven watertight bulkheads are fitted extending to the upper deck.
2. Ceiling has been laid on the inner bottom under the hatchways.
3. Cargo battens are fitted, but no details are recorded.
4. A vertical sliding watertight door has been fitted at the entrance to the tunnel.

A first Entry report on the machinery of the vessel is being prepared and will be forwarded as soon as possible.
