Hatch coaming of cross bunker amidships and on port and starboard sides on main deck removed and deck plated over.

New 4" air pipes fitted to the oil fuel bunker and settling tanks. *920 1/2" above bridge deck*

Additional air pipes fitted to double bottom tank No. 2 a on port and starboard sides.

All air pipes to oil fuel tanks fitted with gauze and steel flaps.

Ash shoot opening in shell on starboard side permanently closed by riveted and E.W. steel plates.
