Dear Sir:

As requested, we have to confirm that the repairs to the fractured ribs in the upper steam port leading to the L.P. cylinder in the main engine of your ship were carried out under the survey, and to the entire satisfaction, of the Society's Surveyors at Toronto who surveyed this engine during construction at the Works of Messrs. John Inglis Co., Ltd. The repairs consist of bolted patches and the securing bolts have been secured against movement by spot welding.

The repairs were examined here after the dock trials and again after the sea trials and were found to be efficient.

This repair is regarded, under existing conditions, as a permanent repair and no reserve is being made against the class of the vessel in respect of same.
