Dear Sirs,

I have to inform you that an application has been received from the Owners of the motorship "JOSIAH MACY" for re-assignment of freeboards in accordance with the Regulations adopted by the Free City of Danzig. These Regulations are in accordance with the recommendations of the 1930 Loadline Convention for Tankers, and in dealing with this case you should be guided thereby.

A report form C11, on which have been entered the figures as supplied by the Owners or as measured from the vessel when built, is enclosed for your guidance. You should ^{verify} these figures from the ship and fill in all the information required on pages 2, 3 and 4 of the report form, and return it to this Office in order that freeboards may be assigned.

The Owners state that the vessel is due at Gothenburg on the 10th July next and on July 12th at Malmo, where the freeboards could be marked and verified. You should therefore forward the particulars as early as possible in order to avoid delay.

A fee of £17 should be charged in this case.
