Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 15th instant, from which it is noted that application has been made by the Owners of the motorship "JOSIAH MACY" for the re-assignment of freeboards in accordance with the Convention Regulations for Tankers.

With regard thereto I have to send herewith a copy of my letter to the Gothenburg Surveyors in the matter, and on receipt of their report a complete copy of the computation will be sent to you for guidance in dealing with the German Authorities.

It is noted that the vessel is stated to be a sister vessel to the "SVITHIOD", particulars of which are already in your possession.

I may add that you may issue a letter to the See-Berufsgenossenschaft stating that the strength of the vessel is suitable for the minimum tanker freeboard.
