Sir,

An application has been received from Messrs. Waried  
Schiff Rhederei, Hamburg, on behalf of the Baltisch-Amerika-  
sche Petroleum Import Gesellschaft m.b.H., Danzig for re-  
assignment of freeboard to the Motorship "Josiah Macy" in  
accordance with the 1930 Lead Line Convention.

Enclosed is a sheet giving the necessary particulars  
of the calculation. The Owners state that the vessel is to be  
surveyed at Gothenburg on the 10th July, 1931, and on the 12th July at  
Helsingborg, and it is proposed to have the survey for freeboards  
at these ports.


As freeboards are also to be assigned to the vessel  
by the See-Berufsgenossenschaft and as the vessel is classed  
with this Society it will be necessary for a letter to be  
applied to the See-Berufsgenossenschaft stating that the  
vessel's strength is sufficient for the reduced freeboard and  
increased draught. I shall be glad however to be advised that it  
will be in order to issue this letter to the See-Berufsgenossen-  
schaft before doing so.
