Motorship "EL BUARO"

I have your letter of the 18th instant and am much obliged to you for the information contained therein.

It does not appear that there is any question as to whether the Committee should agree to the postponement of the Special Survey seeing that the classis already qualified by a notation of "Laid up - Surveys overdue", and such notation will remain until all surveys have in fact been completed. Should the vessel re-enter service without the overdue surveys being held, the Committee would doubtless expunge the vessel's class from the Register Book but as it is noted she is still laid up, it is considered the entry in the Society's Register Book should remain as at present, and it will be appreciated if you will kindly make the point clear to Mr. Escobar.
