With reference to your letter of the 26th October and my reply of the 5th November, 1954, I have to inform you that in view of the fact that this vessel became due for Special Survey at the end of May last, also that she had not been seen in drydock since September, 1953 and that the machinery Continuous Survey was behind-hand this vessel's class has been qualified in the Society's Register Book with the notation "Laid up - Surveys overdue".

A letter has now been received from Messrs. Anglo-Ecuadorian Oilfields, Ltd., London, in which they state this vessel was sold to Senor E. Escobar, a resident in Ecuador, and handed over to him on the 29th ultimo. It is also stated that the vessel will continue to trade in Ecuadorian and Peruvian coastal waters.

In the circumstances it will be appreciated if you will endeavour to get in touch with the new Owner and let me know what are his intentions with a view to retention of the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book.
