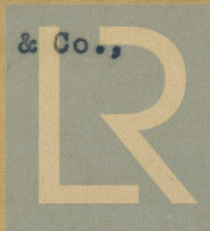
I have to add that the report forwarded with your letter of the 16th August made no mention of this matter.
