From the Lloyd's Agents' report of survey held at Callao August/October, 1953, it was concluded that there was a stream anchor on board.

In reply to an enquiry the Lloyd's Agents' Surveyor at Lima in a letter dated 26.4.54 advises that there is no stream anchor on board at present.

When this ship was under Special Survey at Balboa March/May, 1951, a stream anchor was reported to be on board.

IT IS SUBMITTED this ship is worthy to be continued as classed, subject to a stream anchor being supplied at the earliest opportunity.

IT IS ALSO SUBMITTED that the Owners be informed of the foregoing deficiency and be requested to advise when and where a stream anchor as required by the Rules will be placed on board.
