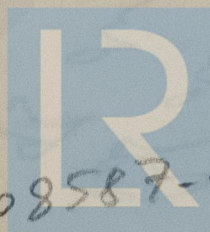
With reference to your letter AJST dated 13th April, 1956, I would inform you that following the purchase of Steam Tug "Nupe" from Messrs. Elder Dempster Lines, Ltd., it is not proposed to continue the classification of this vessel which will be operated purely on lighterage services within the port of Freetown.

2. The boiler and screwshaft were duly surveyed by Government Surveyors in February last and this vessel will continue to be maintained up to the high standard required for Government owned craft.
