M.S. "INSUMAR".

Further to my letter of yesterday, a copy of which is enclosed, the following information might make the position regarding the m.s. "Insumar" a little clearer.

The Head Office of PERINDO is at Menado, a rebel stronghold, or was so until recently. The former Managing Director decided about a year ago to join up with the rebels and from that time until a few weeks ago the "INSUMAR" has been in rebel hands and has laid idle at Menado, hence the long period between dockings.

PERINDO as I stated yesterday is the abbreviation for Pelajaran Rakjat Indonesia, their address is Djalan Pahlawan, Menado.

The other ship classed with Lloyd's Register under the management of PERINDO is the m.s. "KAKAP". At present the ship is under the control of the army and Perinde have no idea when they will have the ship returned.

Another ship on your list of 23rd September 1958 has been sunk by the rebels, this is the m.s. "NUBURI". I can not give the date of the sinking. *Rpts please*

I'm sorry I could not give you this information yesterday, but I have no wish to clash with our friends here over what they might consider a security matter.


