Sir:

I beg to advise you that I have now disposed of the steamer
"Ayr", official number 99738 to Italian Buyers and
completed the deal this morning. I must therefore, notify you that
she is being withdrawn from class as purchasers are putting her
under the Italian flag and Register Italiano.

According to the terms of our agreement I am to furnish the
drawing plans of the vessel:- Profile, Amidships Section and
Deck Arrangements. No doubt you will have these in your records
as I have not been able to obtain same from Builders, who have
probably destroyed them, or any other source, I should esteem it
to my favour if you could let me have the plans deposited with
you, or, if this is not possible, a photographic copy in order that
I may complete my obligations with the Buyers. I will be quite
able to pay any expenses entailed and shall be extremely obliged
if you will let me have an early reply to this letter.
