We have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 13th November in which you asked whether we are in a position to furnish you with any further information concerning the above vessel.

This will advise you that the vessel left Ciudad Trujillo on 13th November, bound for the U.K. The question of the renewal of the air pump liner will be reviewed on the vessels' arrival, when we learn the Ministry's decision concerning her future.


We also have to acknowledge receipt of your letter of 14th November in which you draw attention to the fact that General Examination for Maintenance of Class will require to be held before the end of January next, that the vessel's Freeboard Certificate will expire on 31st January and that the Boiler Survey becomes due at the end of April 1948. Whether or not
