I am directed to acquaint you that in accordance with the decision of the Committee set forth in the attached statement, a **"EMPIRE SUCCESS"** for maintenance of class of the above-named vessel will require to be held before the end of **General Examination** and I shall be glad to learn, for the information of the Committee, **January next** what arrangements are proposed to be made to submit her for the requisite inspection.
