## "EMPIRE SUCCESS"

We are in receipt of your letter of the 29th September concerning the report of survey carried out by your Surveyors at Halifax in June last.

After the repairs named were carried out at Halifax the vessel proceeded to La Romana, Cuba, to load sugar. Unfortunately she has been detained at that port on account of engine defects, mainly auxiliary, since 16th July. Our latest information is that the vessel is expected to leave that port for the United Kingdom about 6th October. In the meantime no action is being taken concerning the renewal of the air pump chamber liner as the future of this vessel is very indefinite. The matter will be further investigated on the vessel's return to the U.K. by which time we may have further instructions from the Ministry regarding her future.
