Dear Sirs,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 5th instant relative to the steamer "IXIA", ex "HAGEN", and in reply to your enquiry I have to state that unless you consider a hydraulic test on the boilers necessary for any special reason, there is no necessity to apply such test purely as a formality. I accordingly telegraphed you to the above effect this morning, as follows:-

"IXIA YOUR LETTER FIFTH INSTANT UNLESS HYDRAULIC TEST ON BOILERS NECESSARY FOR ANY SPECIAL REASON THERE IS NO NECESSITY APPLY SUCH TEST PURELY AS FORMALITY".
