Dear Sirs,

Reverting to your letter of the 20th instant in regard to the Steamer "IXIA" ex "HAGEN", I have to acquaint you that the plans forwarded by you have been examined and that the scantlings and equipment indicated thereon could be approved for the class 100A. I have to request, however, that you will verify the scantlings and report on a First Entry form.

The requirements of the Rules for vessels not built under survey should be complied with, but in the existing circumstances your request to be allowed to use your discretion in such matters as chipping and scaling is agreed to.

In compliance with your request the First Entry Report and the following plans of the sister ship "BOCHUM" are to-day being forwarded to you under separate cover for your guidance in holding the survey:-
