Dear Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 29th July last, in which you enquire whether you are entitled to charge any fee in the case of a fresh freeboard certificate being required in connexion with the change of name of a ship, similar to the survey held by you on the steamer "KAWATIRI" ex "Shahristan".

In reply I have to inform you that in cases where new certificates, on account of change of name, are required under the present Regulations (not the Convention Regulations), a fee should be charged by you in accordance with the nature and extent of the services rendered and the custom of your port.
