A PERIODICAL SPECIAL SURVEY (C) became due in 2,50.

A notation of "Laid-up Pending Survey" is recorded in the Register Book.

The GRIMSBY Surveyors report (4,51) the SPECIAL SURVEY commenced by the examination of the vessel in dry dock.

The new Owners request in a letter dated 25.4.51, the vessel be withdrawn from Classification.

As the SPECIAL SURVEY is now 14 months overdue the case is submitted for the consideration of the Committee.
