Steam Trawler "SHEDDON"

The above trawler has been under survey at this port for commencement of the Special Survey and L.M.C.

All the Rule requirements remain to be carried out except the following now examined:-

Bottom, keel and rudder.
Propeller, screwshaft (drawn in), sea connections,
outside fastenings.
Boiler internally and externally, safety valves,
mountings, manhole doors.

The vessel has left this port and no opportunity was given to see the boiler under steam and adjust the safety valves.
