QUESTION.

With reference to the entry in our returns of vessels under survey dated the 30th ultimo and 13th instant, we have to point out that the validity of the "Examined" notation will expire at the end of the present month. Under the new arrangements in accordance with Circular No. 1862, a Special Survey should now be held. The Committee realise, however, that it may not be possible for arrangements to be made for such an inspection within the limited time now available, and while they strongly advocate this should be done if at all possible, they will not object to class continuance for a further short period on satisfactory completion of a General Examination. We shall therefore be glad to learn what action is being taken in the matter on the occasion of your present survey.

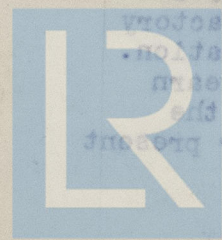
