We have to-day been informed by 'phone by the Owners' Agent at Genoa, Mr. Virginio TORTORA, that the new Owners of this ship are :

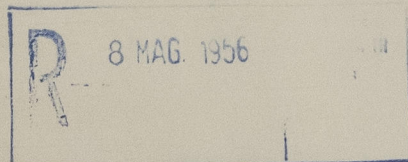
