The Society's Surveyors at Newcastle recently issued a certificate on Rpt.10 in the case of the motorship "ARGENTARIO" ex "AFRICAN QUEEN" to permit the vessel being towed to Italy as a hulk. Her class in the Register Book is qualified by a notation of "Laid up - surveys overdue" - the inspections in question being the Special Survey which became due in 11,54., the W.T. Donkey Boiler Survey and the Screwshaft Survey.
