In reply to your Classing Letter dated 23rd January last, we have to state that the W.T. doors on 'tween deck bulkheads No.74 (p.& s.) and No.96 (p.s.) have been retained as originally fitted and are operated from above the freeboard deck. The W.T. doors (p.& s.) on 'tween deck Bulkhead No.45 have been removed and the apertures slightly enlarged for access.


The double bottom tanks for particulars in Register Book are as stated in your letter i.e:
