QUESTION.

It is noted from your letter of the 23rd instant that this vessel has been sold to A/S. Hetland, Copenhagen, and that alterations are proposed. It will be appreciated that the vessel is considerably overdue for Special Survey of hull and machinery, and Screwshaft Survey.
