S(Y). I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 14th instant relative to the Steel Auxiliary Twin Screw Schooner Yacht "WESTWARD", and in reply I have to say that while you are correct in pointing out that the Re-classification Survey of this vessel was completed so recently as April last, you will, doubtless, recollect that the inspection in question was commenced so long ago as October, 1935. The Special Survey of the Machinery and the major portion of the hull requirements were carried out in October, 1935/April, 1936, and when the vessel was re-classed in April last she was assigned notations of s.s.Sou.No.3- 4,36, HLMC 4,36 and D.B.S. 4,38, and in accordance with the Society's Rules, periodical surveys become due as under, viz:-

Modified Machinery Survey became due in April, 1938, i.e., two years after date of complete Survey of the Machinery.

Donkey Boiler Survey becomes due in April, 1939, i.e., twelve months from date of previous Donkey Boiler Survey.
