The position following receipt of your Report No. 2298 was that the Special Survey of the hull was complete, but that to complete the Continuous Survey of the oil engines the following items remain to be examined:-

All independent pumps except ballast, feed and lubricating oil cooling, Condenser, Oil fuel tanks, Steering gear, Steam pipes over 3" bore, and Oil burning arrangements.

The question as to the completion of this inspection has been taken up with the Society's New York Office and the following cablegram has now been received:-

"PACIFIC PEARL REPORTED SOLD IN JAPAN BY COURT ORDER AND STATED NOW AT SHIPYARD THERE"

It is not known as to whether the ship is still at your port, but if it is, I shall be glad if you will furnish me with any information you are able to ascertain as to the new Ownership and the intentions of the new Owners in regard to completion of the above inspection if it is the Owners' desire to retain the Society's Classification.

An early reply is desired in view of the fact that the year of grace for the Special Survey expired at the end of June last.
