With reference to the Special Survey which became due at the end of June, 1956, and which has been held on the hull, I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Owners and let me know as soon as possible what early definite arrangements are proposed to be made for the Continuous Survey Cycle of the Oil Engines to be completed.

All independent pumps except ballast, feed and lub. oil cooling,
Condenser,
Oil fuel tanks,
Steering gear,
Steam pipes over 3" bore, and
Oil burning arrangements.
