Dear Sirs,

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyor at Wellington, N.Z. has forwarded to this Office your letter of the 9th ultimo intimating that you have decided to withdraw the classification of your steamers "HOLMDALE" and "JOHN" from the Society's Register Book, in view of the refusal of the Marine Department of the New Zealand Government to recognise the certificates of the Society's Surveyors, and I have to say that in these circumstances the Committee have given instructions for the classes of these vessels to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu in each case, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of these vessels' classes the records of freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draughts, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificates are thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
