on the (Date of examination) 22nd July, 1947.


I have to report that I found<sup>s</sup>

- Foremast (steel) in good condition. No mast wedges.
- No topmast fitted.
- Shrouds and stays in good order.
- Rigging screws and eyeplates in good order.
- Split pin broken in upper bolt of S.A. shroud rigging screw, to be renewed.
- Mainmast (steel) in good condition. No mast wedges.
- No topmast fitted.
- Shrouds and stays in good order.
- Rigging screws and eyeplates in good order.
- Split pins to renew in P. & S. aft shrouds and centre stay on fore side of mast as pointed out.
- Derrick posts at No. 3 hatch with stays, screws and eyeplates in good order.
- Funnel stays - 6 in Number require renewal.
- Screws to overhaul. Eyeplates in good order.
