With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "TOCANTINA", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had the case of this vessel under their consideration, together with a cable on the subject received from the Society's Surveyor at Rio de Janeiro.

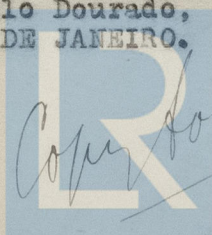
The Committee regret to learn that it is not your desire that the class of the vessel should be retained in the Register Book, and in view of the fact that the Second Special Survey No. 1 became due so long ago as June, 1919, and has not yet been completed, they have given instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I may add, however, that immediately upon the receipt of a satisfactory report from the Society's Surveyors to the effect that the necessary survey and repairs have been carried out, the case of the vessel will be eligible to be submitted to the Committee with a view to the reinstatement of her classification.
